

### Remembering April Rifenburg

As we head into obedience today, I invite you to rest your hearts and minds on long time Berner person, April Rifenburg, who died in late February.

April earned High in Trial with her Berner, Heid, in 1980, 1983 and 1986 and also 1982 with Nitro. The Heidi 's Legacy Trophy, which is given each year to the team that is High in Trial at the BMDCA National Specialty, was named for April's dog and she donated that trophy to the BMDCA.
