

## DRAFT TEST STEWARDS

Stewards are responsible for assisting the judges during both the ring exercises and during the Freight Haul and may act only on the judges' instructions. At no time should a steward appear to be discussing judging.

### Qualifications

- Friendly individuals who are willing to follow directions
- Physical fitness/condition enabling being on feet most of the day and accompanying half-mile freight hauls
- Previous experience as an exhibitor or steward at a BMDCA Draft Test is helpful but not required.
- Familiarity with the BMDCA's Draft Regulations is helpful but not required

### Time Commitment

This is a four to eight hour assignment (depending on the schedule and number of volunteers; lunch should be provided when full-shift is served). The stewarding assignment may also involve assisting with set-up and clean-up, requiring work well after the last draft exhibitor is gone. Stewards should be present and listen to judge's session for entrants.

### Responsibilities

- Ring Exercises - Stewards are needed to tend the gate and position the rigs (1), set the narrows (1-2), provide distractions (2) and for loading and unloading exercises (2).
- Freight Haul - A lead steward should be assigned for the freight hauls and other stewards should be available to assist in accordance with the judges' instructions.
- Set-up and clean-up as assigned.
