## DRAFT TEST STEWARDS

Stewards are responsible for assisting the judges during both the ring exercises and during the Freight Haul and may act only on the judges' instructions. <u>At no time</u> should a steward appear to be discussing judging.

## **Qualifications**

- Friendly individuals who are willing to follow directions
- Physical fitness/condition enabling being on feet most of the day and accompanying halfmile freight hauls
- Previous experience as an exhibitor or steward at a BMDCA Draft Test is helpful but not required.
- Familiarity with the BMDCA's Draft Regulations is helpful but not required

## **Time Commitment**

This is a four to eight hour assignment (depending on the schedule and number of volunteers; lunch should be provided when full-shift is served). The stewarding assignment may also involve assisting with set-up and clean-up, requiring work well after the last draft exhibitor is gone. Stewards should be present and listen to judge's session for entrants.

## Responsibilities

- Ring Exercises Stewards are needed to tend the gate and position the rigs (1), set the narrows (1-2), provide distractions (2) and for loading and unloading exercises (2).
- Freight Haul A lead steward should be assigned for the freight hauls and other stewards should be available to assist in accordance with the judges' instructions.
- Set-up and clean-up as assigned.
